The Program in Genetic Counseling will be an innovative, 21-month Master's degree program. Students will complete:

- 13 didactic courses
- 5 clinical rotations
- mentored research project

The Program is in the process of obtaining New Program Accreditation Status from the Accreditation Council of Genetic Counseling. We anticipate that applications will be available in Fall 2020 and accepted students will begin classes in the Fall 2021 semester.
