The Master of Science in Genetic Counseling program at the University of Pennsylvania is a two-year, 21-month, full-time, accredited training program for careers in the exciting, rapidly-changing field of genetic counseling.

Applicants from communities under-represented in genetic counseling are eligible and encouraged to apply for the scholarship by submitting a brief additional essay when they apply to the UPenn MSGC program.



The application deadline for the UPenn MSGC program is **December 20th** for classes starting in the fall semester of the next year.

The scholarship covers tuition, fees, travel to meetings, and provides a generous educational fellowship for other costs.



Five MSGC programs participate in the Alliance. Two scholarships per year are offered at each of the following schools:

2. Boston University School of Medicine
3. Sarah Lawrence College, New York
4. Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey
